3. Declare His be done. (Luke 11:2)
4. Request your be met. (Luke 11:3)
5. Request your be forgiven. (Luke 11:4)
6. Request over temptation. (Luke 11:4)
When we pray like it unlocks God's power in our life.

Talk it Over:

"How to Pray"

Big Idea:

Prayer is powerful because we get to talk to the All-Powerful God! So, ask & keep asking!

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever become so frustrated that you stopped praying for a season? What was the result? What lessons did you learn from the experience?
- •What are some ways you keep your prayer life fresh & vibrant?
- Have you ever been surprised when God answered one of your prayers? Has He ever done more than what you asked? What does it reveal about God's nature when He answers prayer in spite of our weakness and doubts?

Prayer Focus This Week:

The world is full of so-called prayer warriors who are prayerignorant. They're full of formulas and programs and advice, peddling techniques for getting what you want from God. Don't fall for that nonsense. This is your Father you are dealing with, and he knows better than you what you need. With a God like this loving you, you can pray very simply. Like this:

"Our Father in heaven, Reveal who you are. Set the world right; Do what's best- as above, so below. Keep us alive with three square meals. Keep us forgiven with you and forgiving others. Keep us safe from ourselves and the Devil. You're in charge! You can do anything you want! You're ablaze in beauty! Yes. Yes. Yes." (Matthew 6:9-13 MSG)
