AIM has planted over 1000 churches in Cambodia, where entire communities are being changed through a relationship with Jesus. Since 2005, the ministries now lead by Don and Bridget Brewster have

focused on ending the evil of child sexual slavery. AIM takes a holistic approach in order to defeat trafficking, restoring victims and transforming communities. AIM is guided by the philosophy that God anointed the Church through the power of Jesus Christ to overcome evil.





Frank and Jan were married at Central and started their ministry working with Hmong refugees living in California and San Jose. Today, they have been ministering in Asia for over 40 years! Their ministry had a 10-year goal of planting 1 million churches and engaging 1,000 unique (unreached) people groups, which they reached 2 years earlier than planned, in



2021. When on the home side, Frank teaches missions courses at William Jessup University and both he and Jan are regular lecturers for "Perspectives on the World Christian Movement" course. Recently due to increased restrictions, Frank and Jan had to leave Asia permanently and

return to the US. But the ministry didn't stop. During that time, they started an online seminary to equip local leaders called "Fidelis" (Latin for "faithful").

In 1977 Jim and Joan left San Jose to work among tribal peoples on the south coast of Irian Jaya, Indonesia (now Papua Indonesia). Within a few years a church was born, and many more years of work brought this church to self- sufficiency. After 17 years in the interior Jim and Joan, along with their three daughters, moved to the coastal town of Sentani where they are now involved in church planting among prostitutes, prison inmates, broken families and troubled youth. Additionally, Jim and his daughter Amy, who manages their free medical clinic, travel with emergency response teams to provide disaster relief and outreach throughout Indonesia as needed. Jim's growing burden is to catalyze church planting movements in Indonesia and Southeast Asia. He is actively involved in training cross-cultural workers as well as the leadership of these emerging churches and has sent out many Papuan "missionaries" to be a blessing to the Nations!


#### PRAYER REQUESTS + FUTURE GOALS

Nadim and Julie Costa minister in Beirut, Lebanon where Nadim serves as the director of Near East Organization for Training, Development & Media. N). His organization trains leaders of churches in the Middle East and North Africa in Pastoral skills as well as church planting. This ministry causes Nadim to travel throughout the Muslim world where training sessions and encouragement of church leaders are often held in clandestine or secret settings. Because of this ministry, many have come to Christ, and Pastors are receiving training that would otherwise be unavailable to them. In the last few years, they have focused on providing aid to refugees from Syria

with food and other basic necessities. These efforts provide opportunities to start Discovery Bible Studies amongst the Muslim refugees and leading several to Christ.

# Saji John

John Foundation - India - Hyderabad (www.johnfoundation.org)

**D**r. Saji John along with his wife Cynthia, are the founders of the John Foundation which ministers to both children and women through Children's Homes, for orphans (262 children in 24 children's homes), Tuition Centers (27 centers with over 700 children), Educational Sponsorship Program for children of single mothers (685 students),



Restoration Homes for girls rescued from trafficking (8 homes with 80 young girls), and two Employable Skills Training Institutes with courses in Tailoring, Computers, Spoken English, Beautician, Electrical and Welding, training around 1280 students every year. Saji and Cynthia have two children, Benedict, 30, and Beulah, 28. They have been part of New Life Assembly of God Church since 1993.

### Shalom

Restricted Access - Africa - Horn of Africa

Shalom (not his real name) lives in eastern Africa with his wife and their five children. Shalom mentors and coaches grassroots leaders, both in the Horn of Africa region (Ethiopia, Sudan, Eritrea, Somalia, and



Djibouti) and globally. His vision is to see transformed communities among the unreached people groups throughout the northeast Africa region by mobilizing, training, equipping, coaching, and mentoring local leaders. Shalom also focuses on establishing church plants primarily in unreached and unengaged Muslim populations. In 2020, Shalom and his teams in eastern Africa served more than 4,000 people, giving them basic food and sanitation materials. This humanitarian aid-built goodwill in the community, and opened doors and built bridges in areas that are predominantly Muslim. Throughout the region, in 2020 alone, more than 14,000 people came to Christ, with half being from Muslim backgrounds. A total of 6,388 were baptized and 1,992 local churches were planted.

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. So, neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. At times, Shalom's future goals seem almost numerically impossible. In the next 10 years, his goal is to plant 30,000 churches and disciple 500,000 people, including building a School of Missions to serve the Horn of Africa region. He is also planning on building a recording studio to record the Bible in the "mothertongue" or "heart language" of various people groups he serves among - as well as a print shop to publish training materials and books in numerous dialects.









# William Jessup University

William Jessup University - USA

William Jessup University and Central Christian Church have a long and wonderful shared history. Both were founded in 1939 for a common purpose and from the very beginning were seen as partners in ministry together. Originally named, San Jose Bible College, the school began with the intent of training individuals for the work of ministry (both church and missions). In the mid



1980's the school realized its impact had changed, as many students were coming for the purpose of establishing a firm Christian foundation for areas of life outside of professional ministry, so, the name was changed to San Jose Christian College. As the role and impact of the school grew, in 2004 it moved to the city of Rocklin, CA and once again changed its name to William Jessup University in honor of the founder of the school, and Central's first Senior Pastor, Bill Jessup!
